Each month only 2 or 3 house burglaries are reported to the police. Garages and outbuilding are broken into and intruders steal, gardening equipment, bicycles, tools and lead from the roofs.

The police advise residents to lock garages and padlock sheds. Mark equipment with postcode or distinctive identifying marks.
